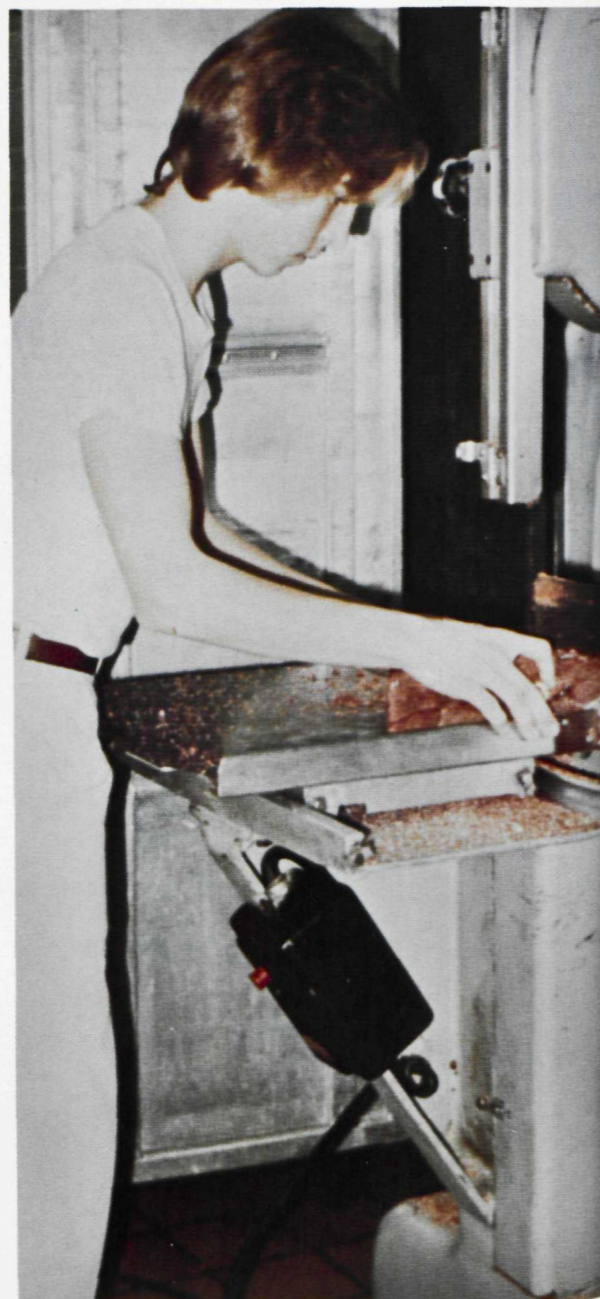


THE SEVENTH HOUR ENDEAVOR
