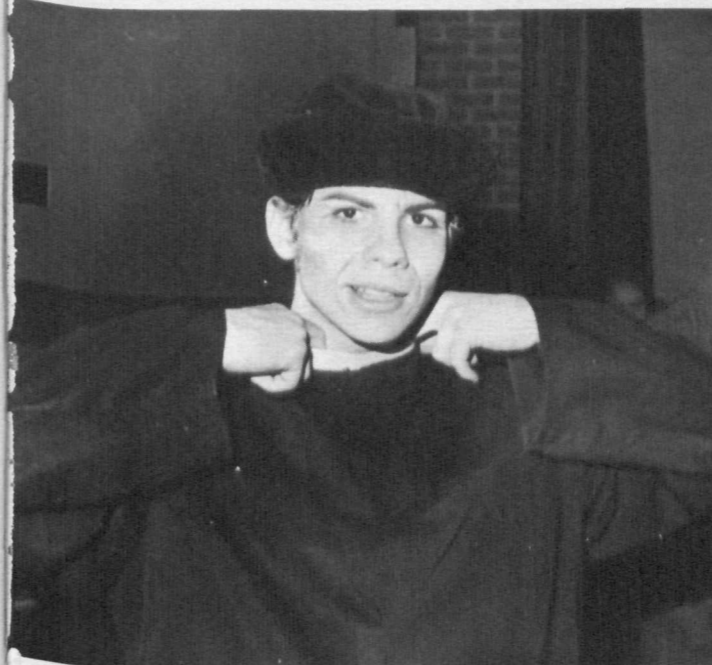
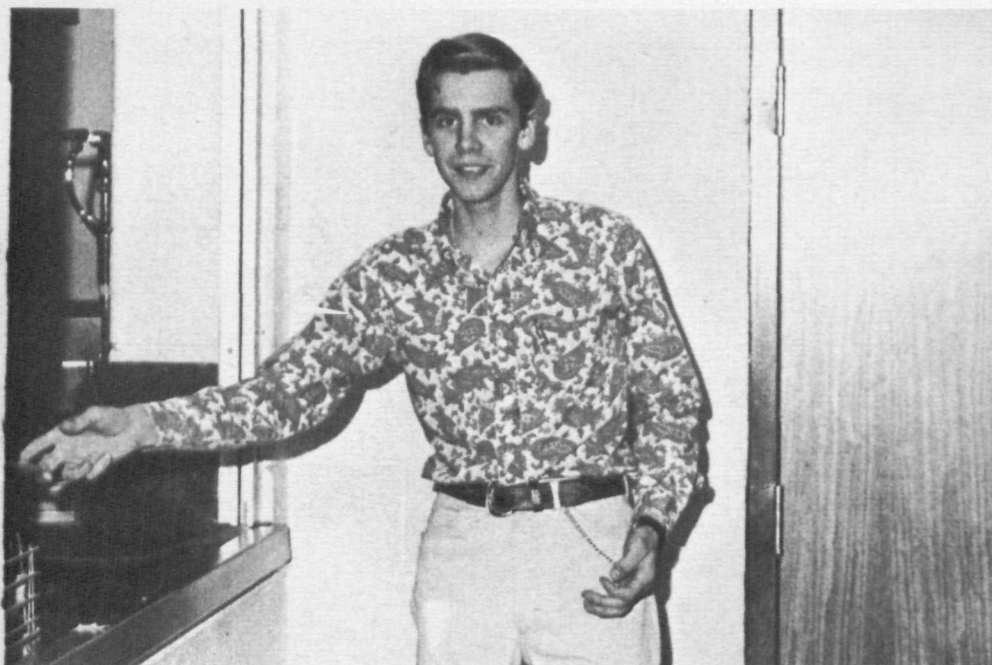
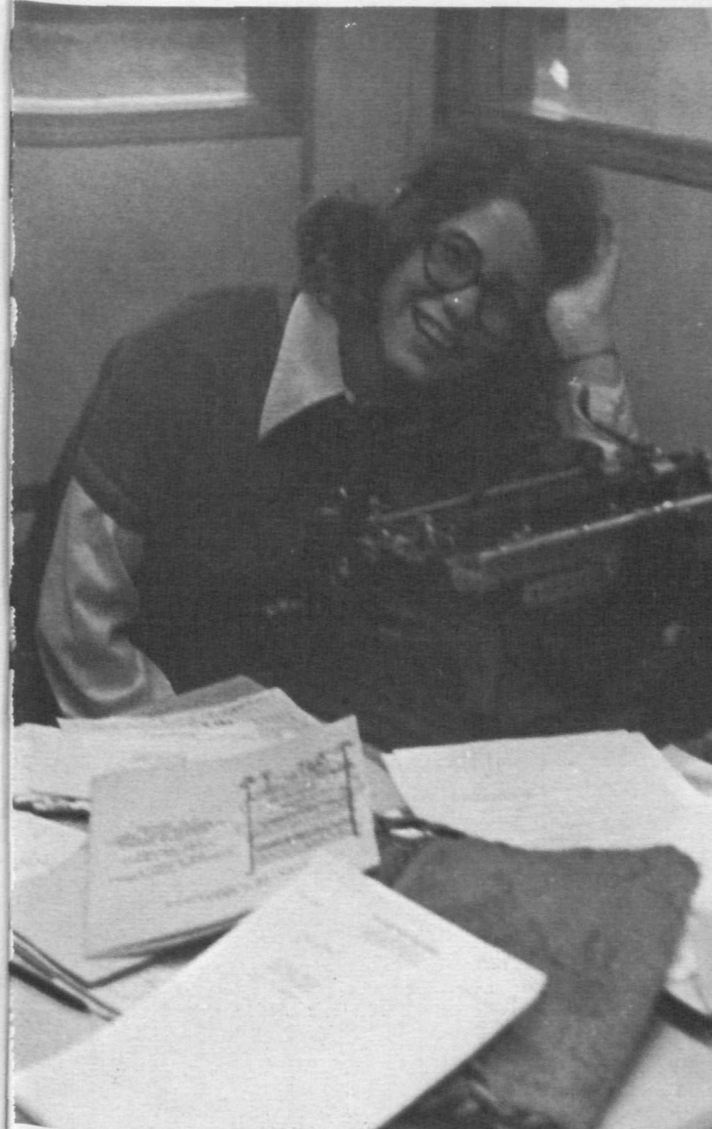


It's Speeches At Commencement For Three: Margaret, Willie, Ron

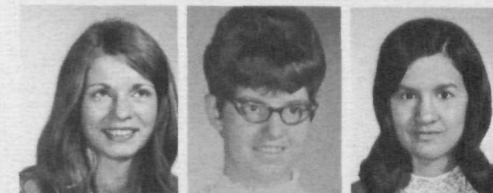
